The Māori Education Trust is offering a new undergraduate scholarship in 2019. If you are eligible to apply and meet the criteria, we encourage you to submit an application.

### ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduate applicants must:

- i. be of New Zealand Māori descent;
- ii. be enrolled at a New Zealand tertiary institute in 2019;
- iii. be attending full-time study for the full year;
- iv. meet the criteria for the scholarships applied for;
- v. submit the application and supporting documentation on time.

### **MĀORI EDUCATION TRUST UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP (New)**

The Māori Education Trust Undergraduate Scholarship is available to Māori undergraduate students who are in their second or third year of study in 2019. Priority will be given to students with financial need.
