

2020 Postgraduate Scholarship Application Form

ELIGIBILITY

Postgraduate applicants must:

- i. be of New Zealand Māori descent (unless applying for the Queen Elizabeth II Postgraduate Fellowship);
- ii. be enrolled at a tertiary institute in 2020;
- iii. be attending study for the full year;
- iv. meet the criteria for the scholarships applied for;
- v. submit the application and supporting documentation on time.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Generic information you need to provide:

- i. Whakapapa verification: This must be completed by a kaumātua, or you may submit an Iwi registration confirmation letter.
- ii. Enrolment confirmation.
- iii. NSN Number. This is your unique ID with the Ministry of Education that you can get from your tertiary institute or NZQA.
- iv. Certified Academic Transcript from last year of study.
- v. At least **one** Academic Reference (unless otherwise stated in scholarship criteria).
- vi. Encoded bank deposit slip or bank verification of your bank account number.
- vii. Curriculum Vitae.

- iii. Evidence that confirms I am a *direct* descendant of Reverend John George Laughton. (***Sister Annie Henry Scholarship only***)
- iv. Evidence that confirms you have received a master's degree. (***Rangiriri And Mātene Te Whiwhi Winiata Scholarship only***)
