

## 2020 Secondary Scholarship Application Form

### ELIGIBILITY

#### Secondary applicants must:

- i. be of New Zealand Māori descent;
- ii. be enrolled at a New Zealand secondary school in 2020;
- iii. meet the criteria for the scholarships applied for;
- iv. submit the application and supporting documentation on time.

### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

#### Generic information you need to provide:

- i. Whakapapa verification: This must be completed by a kaumātua or you may submit a copy of the Iwi registration letter of either parent, however your name **MUST** be shown on the letter to be registered. **(Note: If you are applying for the EC Holmes Memorial Scholarship, you will need your whakapapa verified by the Ngāti Kahungunu Ki Wairarapa Tāmaki Nui ā Rua Post Settlement Governance Entity Trust administrator)**
- ii. Enrolment confirmation.
- iii. NSN Number. This is your unique ID with the Ministry of Education that you can get from your school office or NZQA.
- iv. Encoded bank deposit slip or bank verification of your bank account number.

#### Scholarship Specific Information you need to provide:

- Proof of income (e.g. pay slip or WINZ letter). A bank statement is acceptable so long as frequency of payments can be seen. **(Māori Education Trust Year 10 And 11, Rose Hellaby, Tī Maru and VW & LM Rosier Scholarships only)**
- A copy of your most recent 2019 school report. **(Rose Hellaby and Tī Maru Scholarships only)**
- Evidence that you are a *direct* descendant of Reverend John George Laughton. **(Sister Annie Henry Scholarship applicants only)**
- 2020 class timetable. **(RJ Graham Scholarship applicants only)**
- Certified copies of your 2019 NCEA results. **(RJ Graham Scholarship and VW & LM Rosier Scholarship applicants only)**
