# Chairperson's Report

---

Tēnā koutou katoa.

It gives me great pleasure to present the Māori Education Trust 2019 Annual Report, which again honours the legacy of the Trust's mission to enable Maori to stand strong, particularly through their learning and educational achievement.

This year the Trust continued to provide financial assistance to Māori students undertaking secondary and tertiary study. In total, 882 students, from Year 9 through to those studying towards a postgraduate degree, benefitted from donors whose generosity enables students to more actively participate in education than they may have.

Many of these students have sent to the Board letters and copies of their academic transcripts. The Board remains heartened and extremely humbled by the letters that outline the range of benefits to the scholarship recipients and their whānau. Recipients speak of the joy, the pride and the relief scholarships bring, being able to purchase required textbooks and equipment, pay fees and buy uniforms. A number of recipients also expressed how their scholarship has inspired them to be a role model to their whānau.

*'Things like this do not happen to me, an ex-freezing worker that decided to enter into this unknown world of study. When I read the email, I read it three times because I couldn't believe it.'*

*'This scholarship enabled me to buy a new laptop...so now I can complete school work at home and spend more time with my family. It has also helped me buy myself my very own stethoscope which has really helped advance my nursing practice...'*

*'The scholarship I received has allowed me to focus more on my studies and less on the financial stressors that come with being a university student.'*

This year, some of us have also enjoyed meeting past recipients, in some cases recipients who received scholarships from the Māori Education Foundation prior to 1993. These people can still recall their pride in selection, and acknowledge the Foundation and donors who supported their education.

As Board members and staff, we celebrate the effort and successes of all Māori students, knowing that work of the Trust is relatively modest, and appreciating the significant value and difference that the scholarships provided by the Trust make in a multitude of ways.





As the Board, we recognise that we have many more opportunities to pursue to ensure we grow our reach in support to Māori students. To do this the Trust has sought to grow its capability and capacity. This year the Board's activities included enhancing our governance requirements to ensure they remain current and fit for purpose to meet internal and external expectations. A governance skills audit was completed to ensure the Trust has the diverse range of skills, knowledge and experience necessary to future-proof the Trust. With the resignation of one of our Board members, the Trust carried out a recruitment process for new Trustees. This year we will welcome new Board members to the Trust, Pania Gray, Hineataura Wilkinson and Tupara Morrison. We look forward to further invigoration and development of our contributions to Māori success.

At an operational level, the Trust administered scholarships in accordance with the kaupapa and instructions of donors, and designed new scholarships in partnership with new donors. Staff participated in undergraduate and postgraduate interviews, and critically, participated in the review of the Data Protection and Use Policy carried out by the Social Investment Agency. It was with great enthusiasm that the Trust also launched a new on-line scholarship application process that we aim to have fully functioning next year.

This year we bid farewell to retiring Board member, Monita (Mo) Delamere. Mo accepted the invitation to join the Board in 2011 and throughout his tenure filled a number of roles, including Co-Chairperson (followed by a term as sole Chairperson), Convenor of the Scholarship Committee and later Convenor of the Finance Committee. On behalf of the Board, I thank Mo for his wisdom, dedication and commitment to the kaupapa, and sincerely wish him a most successful time.

As 2019 draws to a close I offer sincere thanks to:

- donors, both past and present, whose incredible generosity has enabled the Trust to continue to support Māori students;
- Māori Education Trust staff, Evelyn Newman and Amy Ririnui, whose drive and intent ensures the best possible service to students and their respective whānau;
- And our continuing Board members – Dame Iritana Tawhiwhirangi, Prue Kapua and Bayden Barber.

## Board Members

**Chairperson, Bronwyn Yates** (Rongowhakaata, Te Aitanga ā Māhaki, Te Arawa and Ngāti Maniapoto), QSM. Bronwyn is a community representative on the Board and was appointed Chairperson of the Trust in November 2018. She has a BA in Political Studies and Māori Studies. Bronwyn has worked in the community education and voluntary sector, primarily in the area of adult literacy, for over 20 years as a tutor, literacy coordinator, national trainer and manager. Bronwyn is Te Tumuaki of Literacy Aotearoa, a Treaty based organisation and the largest national network of adult literacy provision throughout New Zealand.

Bronwyn is on a number of advisory groups including Government reference groups; the ACE Sector Strategic Alliance; the Literacy Alliance; NorthTec Council; NZQA Whakaruruhau Te Mātauranga Māori me Te Whakangungu; NZQA Whakaruruhau Matua; and Global Women.

**Dame Iritana Tawhiwhirangi** (Ngāti Porou, Ngāti Kahungunu and Ngāpuhi, English, Canadian), MBE and DNZM. Dame Iritana is the nominee of the Kohanga Reo National Trust.

Dame Iritana is a member of a number of advisory boards including: Police Commissioner Māori Forum Advisory; Ako Aotearoa Board; Māori Women's Welfare League (Life Member); Adjunct Professor of Te Wānanga o Aotearoa and Patron of the Stem Cell Foundation. She is also a member of King Tuheitia Tekaumarua and the Oranga Tamariki Māori Enquiry.

Over the years, Dame Iritana has travelled internationally speaking on Te Kohanga Reo, education and community development. She became a Dame Companion of the New Zealand Order of Merit in 2009 for services to Māori education. In Hōngongoi (July) 2018, Dame Iritana received Māori Television's Te Toi o Nga Rangi Lifetime Achievement Award.

**Prue Kapua** (Ngāti Whakaue, Te Arawa and Ngāti Kahungunu). Prue is the National President of Te Roopu Wahine Maori Toko i te Ora (the Maori Women's Welfare League) and nominee of this group.

Prue is member of a number of advisory groups including: WHO Compliance Panel (MOH), Chair; Tekau ma rua, member; NZCCSS Family and Policy Group, member; Breast Cancer Foundation NZ, Trustee; Interim Te Rōpū Joint Venture Business Unit on Family and Sexual Violence, Chair; Oranga Tamariki Māori Design Group, Co-chair; and is a member of the Waitangi Tribunal. She is a highly experienced lawyer with expertise in resource management law, Treaty issues and litigation, family and medico legal-issues. Prue is Principal of Tamatekapua Law.

**Monita Delamere** (Te Whānau-a-Apanui, Te Whakatōhea and Ngāi Tahu). A community representative, Mo is a chartered accountant with wide experience in public practise and the corporate world, and has deep experience in governance roles in education.

In 1962 Mo was the recipient of a grant from the Māori Education Foundation to help with his accountancy studies. No reira, ngā mihi ki a rātou ngā tīpuna i whakatō te kākano o tenei roopu.

**Bayden Barber** (Ngāti Kahungunu, Ngāpuhi and Ngāi Tahu). Bayden is the nominee of Te Kaunihera Māori o Aotearoa (the New Zealand Māori Council).

Bayden has extensive experience working within Māori communities, including marae, hapū and iwi. He is a graduate from Te Panekiretanga o Te Reo and has run his own consultancy business for the past 12 years.

Bayden is a member of the Institute of Directors and is an experienced governor with directorships on a number of boards. He is the Chair of Health Hawke's Bay and Te Pītau Health Alliance. He is an elected member of the Hastings District Council and a Trustee of Te Mata Park Trust.

Bayden and his wife Myra have seven children and live in Waimārama, Hawke's Bay.

2019 scholarships, some dating back as far as early 1962, provided financial assistance to 882 students and came from three category sources:

- i. Income trusts where the Trust receives income from external sources;
- ii. Capital trusts in which donors have provided capital sums to endow scholarships; and
- iii. Trust investment.

These sources were supported by a scholarship subsidy provided by the Ministry of Education, an arrangement entered into when the Foundation was formed in 1961. The Ministry also provided an administration grant to assist with the management and disbursement of scholarships.

We thank the Ministry for their ongoing support, financial contribution to scholarships and scholarship administration.

Two of the above scholarships were offered for the first time in 2019. These are:

- **Awhina Nursing Scholarship**

**DONOR: Te Roopu Kotahitanga**

The Awhina Nursing Scholarship was made possible by the fundraising efforts of past Māori nursing students of Manawatu Polytechnic (now the Universal College of Learning [UCOL]).

In early 2000, Māori nursing students were granted the right to hold the annual National Māori Nursing Students Hui at Ratana Marae. Their fund raising efforts resulted in surplus funds which were then invested. As a result, the Awhina Nursing Scholarship was established in 2019 and will provide financial assistance to nursing students for some years.

The scholarship is targeted to Māori nursing students in their second or subsequent year of study for a Bachelor of Nursing, enrolled at the Palmerston North Campus of UCOL. In 2019 Te Roopu Kotahitanga awarded two scholarships of \$500 each to students enrolled in other UCOL campuses, given no applications were received from the Palmerston North Campus.

- **Whanake – HERA Scholarship**

**DONOR: Heavy Engineering Research Association (HERA)**

Established in 1978, the Heavy Engineering Research Association (HERA) was born out of a necessity to help its industry navigate its way through a testing industrial environment in the late 70's. And today, still continues this structure and approach as they come face to face with new challenges.

HERA's team of researchers and key personnel aim to deliver a wide spectrum of research and development support for their members and work closely with universities and organisations to keep their members one step ahead.

To further HERA's aim to strengthen and extend their industry's capacity, HERA targeted the 2019 Whanake – HERA Scholarship to a female Māori student in their first year of a four-year Bachelor of Engineering degree (B.E., or B.Eng).

The scholarship comprises an annual scholarship award of \$5,000 and paid summer internship (with HERA) over four years. The 2019 recipient is in her first-year of a four-year B.E., at Massey University, Palmerston North.

The 2020 scholarship will be open to both female and male Māori engineering students in their first year of a B.E., or B. Eng., degree.

In addition, the Māori Education Trust offered the following scholarships:

- Edward Carlton Holmes Memorial Scholarship
- MET Year 10 and 11 Scholarship
- MET Undergraduate Scholarship
- MET Postgraduate Scholarship - STEM
- MET Postgraduate Scholarship - Hapū or Iwi Development



Applicants who applied for the Hapū or Iwi Development Scholarship were required to submit a letter of support from their Hapū or Iwi Chairperson (or a similar position). Letters spoke highly of applicants and the relevance of their study in relation to the strategic interests of their respective Hapū or Iwi. Scholarship recipients are undertaking study in the following degrees:

- Doctorate in Philosophy (to increase productivity and sustainability of their Iwi farming operations).
- Master of Business Administration (to provide leadership to Trustees of their marae).
- Master of Māori and Indigenous Leadership (to assist their Iwi to manage settlement assets).
- Master of Māori Studies (to strengthen the infrastructure and operation of their Iwi).
- Master of Māori Visual Arts (to participate in the repatriation of their Iwi carvings and revive historical korero and knowledges within Māori arts).

This scholarship shows the value of scholarships, not solely to the recipient, but whānau, Hapū and Iwi.

Your scholarship reflects whakapapa in the way that as Māori we are connected and through this process of support you are valuing my voice and that of my research participants. Our collective voices and thoughts are a taonga which reflect aspirations and hopes for our tamariki to be confident, culturally grounded, digitally skilled and creators of knowledge who know who they are, where they are from and are navigators of their own future. Through your gift, aroha is expressed in that I am able to continue my journey as a teina and Māori researcher and through this gift, my wairua is being kept safe as well.

Once again, on behalf of myself and my whānau, thank you Rangiriri and Mātene Te Whiwhi Winiata for your generosity which I am incredibly humbled to receive. I will honour your belief in my research by carrying out my studies to the best of my ability whilst reflecting and honouring Kaupapa Māori practices and principles. I would like to express my sincere appreciation and gratitude to the Ti Maru Māori Trust for the award of a postgraduate scholarship. This funding will enable me to further my career as a Māori researcher and I intend to use it in a way that will benefit the wider Māori community.

I am a second year PhD student studying Microbiology at the University of Otago. The purpose of my PhD research is to positively influence primary industries within Aotearoa and foster sustainable agriculture. Of particular importance to me is the role that antimicrobials have in the animal industry, and the important need for improved antimicrobial stewardship. My research aims to develop novel antimicrobials for agricultural use and prevent the unnecessary consumption of medically-relevant human antimicrobials by livestock.

By ensuring the correct use of antimicrobials in agriculture, this will have flow on effects for all people, particularly Māori who are disproportionately treated with antibiotics. My research in this area also strongly asserts kaitiakitanga from a science perspective and aims to improve environmental outcomes of primary production practises. To this end, I believe my course of study will be beneficial to the wider Māori community.

With the aid of the Ti Maru Māori Trust postgraduate scholarship, I intend to present my research at an international conference in 2020 and devote more of my time to Māori science outreach and engagement initiatives. I would encourage all aspiring Māori researchers to apply for the Māori Education Trust scholarships.
