



## 2022 Te Taura Whiri and the Māori Education Trust Tertiary Scholarship Application

Te Taurawhiri i te reo Māori in partnership with the Māori Education Trust will have tertiary scholarships available for students of te reo Māori and students who will use te reo Māori as the main component of their tertiary studies. This includes:

Study	Criteria	Amount	Number of Recipients
<b>Year 1</b> Te Rito Scholarship	Available to students transitioning to tertiary study who wish to study te reo Māori. These students will have completed secondary study at either Wharekura or one of the Māori Boarding Schools	\$2,000	40
<b>Undergraduate</b> Te Māhui Scholarship	Available to students who are completing undergraduate studies in te reo Māori.	\$2,000	40
<b>Postgraduate</b> Te Haemata Scholarship	Available to students completing their postgraduate studies in te reo Māori.	\$20,000	2

### Applicants must:

- be of New Zealand Māori descent);
- be enrolled at a tertiary institute in 2022;
- be attending study for the full year;

### Information you must provide:

- Whakapapa verification: This must be completed by a kaumātua, or you may submit an Iwi registration confirmation letter.
- Enrolment confirmation.
- Bank verification of your bank account number.

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
